

## **Face Covering Acknowledgement and Agreement**

Effective July 1, 2020

Given the widespread community transmission of COVID-19, Smith Early Care and Education remains committed to providing high-quality, compassionate and safe care to children and families while ensuring the safety of our workforce. To this end, employees and visitors will be required to wear a face covering while on Smith Early Care and Education premises and when performing any activity which would involve close contact or proximity to co-workers/children and where six feet separation is not feasible. We recognize that this is a departure from our standard practice; however, local counties have published orders requiring all persons to wear cloth face coverings while at work. These practices will be continually monitored and reevaluated.

Face coverings may include homemade masks, scarfs, or bandanas.
